*Good Question* is a technique derived from the cognitive interview which is widely used in the UK to draw out crucial evidence from vulnerable witnesses.

Dr Suzanne Conboy-Hill was a consultant clinical psychologist for adults with intellectual disabilities from 1989 to 2012 and modified the cognitive interview for consent after researching it for her Master's degree in forensic psychology.
